### Travel to Les Cayes, Haiti

*This condensed version is extrapolated from the original report, submitted in November, 2016.*

Our travel was initiated due to an ever present and urgent desire to help fellow Christians in Haiti. A dozen mission workers flew from the U.S., to the international airport in Port Au Prince, Haiti on August 15, 2016. Our mission workers, originating from Evangel Assembly of God in Camp Springs, Maryland included one worker from the Holy Temple Church in Southeast Washington, D.C. By way of local bus travel, we arrived in Les Cayes, at Hosanna House our lodging quarters, about 11:00 P.M. Immediately, we were greeted by Pastor Ignace Augustine, 77 years of age, founder and president of Bethanie Evangelical Mission, Sister Franchette Augustine, his wife and a contingent of local school children.

Preparations for this international mission included prayers, personal finances and supplies for youth Vacation Bible School, (VBS). Our daily mission's group activities included: (1) morning devotional periods led by a different team worker each day; (2) teaching and supervising VBS classes; (3) resurfacing and painting classroom walls; (4) constructing wood benches for pews; and (5) evening worship services where different mission workers spoke from the Bible, the Word of God. These mission works were perpetuated by our hosts who were determined to be kingdom builders for God. On various occasions, Pastor I. Augustine or Sister Franchette, his wife, were our language interpreters.
